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Journal of Chemical Technology and Metallurgy publishes full-length research papers, short communications, critical and book reviews. Research papers are expected to be complete and authoritative accounts of work that has significance and interest, presented clearly and concisely.

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The manuscript with a letter confirming that presented data is new and has not been published or submitted elsewhere as well as the manuscript is relevant to the topics pointed above, will be considered. Authors have to declare that they have not conflict of interests. Presentation and discussion should be at the level of the Journal status gained. The language can be a reason for rejection if below an acceptable level of clarity. Detailed descriptions of the equipment used should only be given if the latter is new. Papers reporting experimental data without adequate interpretation are not acceptable. Contributions will be accepted for publication only on the recommendation of referees.

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State the objectives of the work and provide an adequate background. Avoid a detailed literature survey or a summary of the results.

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Results and the discussion provided should be clear and concise.
